ROAD SAFETY ON FIPASS

Recently there has been a significant rise in the number of Road Traffic Collisions (RTC) on FIPASS and the aim of this notice is to remind all FIPASS Users of the Ordnance and Regulation that are in force on FIPASS and remind everyone of their legal responsibility to comply with the road traffic ordinance and regulation whilst in charge of a motor vehicle or piece of plant machinery on FIPASS.

Section 2 of reference A defines "road" as including any street, thoroughfare, highway, lane, court, alley, passage, or open place used or frequented by the public, or to which the public have or are permitted to have access in Stanley or within a radius of four miles of the boundary thereof and shall also include any other street, thoroughfare, highway, lane, court, alley, passage or open place declared by the Governor by order to be a road for the purpose of this Ordinance

Pursuant to regulation 3(5) of reference B the structure known as FIPASS including the causeway has a speed limit of ten miles per hour.

In summary please ensure the following;

- 1. Do not exceed the 10mph speed limit.
- 2. Do not use a mobile phone whilst driving/operating.
- 3. Ensure you are fit to drive/operate.
- 4. Ensure you report any RTC's to the Atlink Ltd Duty Operations Manager immediately and complete an Accident Report Form within 24 hours of the RTC.
- 5. Ensure you wear a seat belt.
- 6. Ensure you report the RTC to the Royal Falkland Islands Police within 24 hours of the RTC.
